To nominate an Affiliate Teacher of the Year for the 2011 National Teacher of the Year Award, complete four steps:

Step 1 – Complete Georgia Teacher of the Year Award nomination form.

Step 2 – Additionally, the following information must be provided, in this order:

- A. Using a maximum of two (2) typed, double-spaced pages, use the categories below as headings and provide background information:
- Community demographics and level of involvement in school activities.
 - School setting (including goals and philosophy; school and family and consumer sciences enrollment; and types of extracurricular activities offered).
 - Program restrictions (because of federal or state regulations and/or school policies such as enrollment, class size, scheduling, program budget, and funding).
- B. Using a maximum of one (1) typed, double-spaced page, describe the specific goal(s) of and list the intended outcomes of the nominee's educational program (include only the information about the program for which the nominee is being nominated).
- C. Program Description
Describe the nominee's educational program. A maximum of ten (10) typed, double-spaced, one-sided pages (or five (5) double-sided pages) in 12-point type with one-inch margins can be submitted for this description. Use the categories below as headings and provide information on or give evidence of the following in narrative form:
- Attainment of the program goals and intended outcomes.
 - Enrollment data and evidence that the program is sustainable and can be replicated.
 - Creativity, innovation, progressive approach to subject matter.
 - Ingenuity and perseverance used to obtain, maximize, and sustain funding and/or overcome obstacles to the program.
 - Integration of family and consumer sciences concepts with subject matter focus and with other disciplines.
 - Influence on students' lives within and beyond the program.
 - Relevant and timely impact on students, school, and/or community.
 - Increased visibility, recognition, appreciation, and support of the profession.
- Supporting materials, photographs, newspaper clippings, etc. can be used to illustrate and explain the program in an attached appendix, up to a maximum of five (5) one-sided pages, following the Program Description.
- D. Provide the following
- i. The affiliate president's letter of nomination should describe what makes the nominee outstanding.
 - ii. Curriculum vitae/resumé that has been updated within the past year.
 - iii. Three letters of support, such as from supervisors, colleagues, parents, students, or community leaders (each letter should give evidence of the impact and importance of the nominee's contributions to students, families, and the community).

Step 3 – Mail one complete and assembled photocopies or labeled CDs of the nomination package (i.e., the nomination form and supporting documents) **postmarked by January 18, 2011**, or earlier to
